## 2018- 2019 BALTO Recipient is the Care Center

The care center is a nationally accredited child advocacy center. It is the only child advocacy center in Oklahoma County. The Care Center works to combat the extensive epidemic of child abuse. 1 in 3 girls and 1 in 5 boys will be abused before their 18th birthday. It is the care center's mission to change these statistics. They serve as a convening organization for many agencies, including law enforcement, child protective services, assistant district attorneys, counseling, and family advocacy. The Care Center also works to combat abuse on the forefront of education. Through their RAWR program, children are educated on how to report and recognize abuse. BALTO's funds this year will be used to build a new building for the Care Center, this building is key to treating child abuse in Oklahoma County as the Care Center is growing extensively.

## 2018 Brick Campaign

---

In 2018 the brick campaign was launched to raise money for BALTO. Alumni of Edmond North are now able to purchase a brick to be placed in the new stadium. Last year 161 bricks were sold to benefit BALTO's recipient, Hugs for Hope. Bricks are available for purchase this year for \$100. Forms will be available soon.

## ENHS'S New Stadium

---

For the first time in school history Edmond north varsity football is playing on its own field. Edmond North's stadium has been upgraded to hold 6,000 spectators. This new stadium was funded by a 111 million school bond package that voters passed in 2017. The stadium was completed before the start of the fall 2018 football season.

## National Merit Semifinalists

---

This year Edmond North's senior class had 13 students named National Merit Semifinalists. These students placed in the top 1% of US high school seniors. This title is earned through academic success in the PSAT, a standardized test taken junior year. In total Edmond Public Schools has 24 total students named as national merit semifinalists, with 13 coming from Edmond North.

## Huskies In Action

### *Football*

### *Cheer*

The ENHS state cheer team won state at the 2018 6A state championship. This title comes after winning for the past 4 years, giving the Huskies a 5-peat! They also were the 6A academic and regional champions.

### *Softball*

The huskies softball team finished the season with an impressive 29-4 record, winning a regional championship, Central Oklahoma Athletic Conference championship, and 2nd place at the 6A state championship.

### *Cross Country*

Edmond North's cross country team is off to an amazing start. With the girls receiving 3rd place and the boys 7th at regionals, both teams are headed to state on October 27th.

### *Volleyball*

The ENHS volleyball team had a great season. They were the city champions beating both Edmond Santa Fe and Edmond Memorial during the regular season. They also were the regional champions.

### *Band*

ENHS band for the first time in 7 years made it into the finals of the Oklahoma Bandmasters Association (OBA) 6A state championship. They placed 8th with a score of 82.10
