Welcome to Edmond North High School! Please take a few minutes to read the following important information regarding enrollment.

## **Enrollment**

Your 8th grade student will be working with their 9th grade counselors to enroll in classes for their freshman year. We ask that you take some time as a family to look over the enrollment packet to make course selections for your student prior to the week of February 14th - 18th when students will input their course selections.

## **Residency**

Edmond Public Schools is one of the fastest growing districts in the state of Oklahoma and in order for us to best serve all students residing within our boundaries, families are required to provide proof of residency and verify enrollment information prior to the start of a new school year. To complete this requirement, a parent/guardian must access and review the online Annual Update to ensure that all important student information is accurate. Access to the Annual Update will be available on (or after) May 1<sup>st</sup>. The Annual Update must be completed before student schedules are released for the 2022-2023 school year.

## **Freshmen Year Support**

It likely seems early to begin conversations about your 8th grader enrolling in high school and we are here to assist you with any questions about the transition. Please make plans to attend our Future Freshman Night on February 3rd at 6pm in the Auditorium at North to hear helpful information regarding the enrollment process. Students will also have a chance to hear from our Husky Mentors who will help mentor and guide them throughout their freshman year.

## ENHS Course Selection Information

The ENHS Counseling and Administrative staff work diligently to provide the specific courses requested by each student to meet individual student needs. The number of requests for any given class determines staffing needs and assignments, thus creating our Master Schedule. After the Master Schedule is created, classes are balanced amongst the determined sections for any given course [as best as possible] to manage and minimize class sizes. **As a result, course requests made during the enrollment process should be made very thoughtfully and deliberately.**

### Enrollment Considerations:

- **Alternate Course Selections:** These are required in the event that a primary course selection can not be scheduled due to other requested course schedule conflicts. As a result, **Alternate Course selections should also be chosen thoughtfully as they may be used to complete a student's schedule.**
- **Introduction to Advance (IA) and Advanced Placement (AP):** There are many benefits to taking IA and AP classes, but they can be extremely demanding.
  - If you are considering IA and/or AP, it is beneficial to speak with your current teachers about their recommendations.
  - Deciding that your classes are too demanding will not result in a schedule change.

### Opportunities to choose and/or change course selections are as follows:

1. **Completing grade-level enrollment forms [early/mid February]-** This is the 1st opportunity to review and request available courses. Student and Parent/Guardian signatures are required on the enrollment form.
2. **Entering chosen courses into Infinite Campus (IC) portal [mid/late February]-** This is when the student will personally meet with a counselor and their course requests will be entered into IC.
3. Students who do not return paperwork will have their schedule assigned to them based on graduation requirements and course availability.
4. **Choose your schedule carefully.** Schedule changes will only be accommodated under circumstances of school error or inappropriate placement (level).

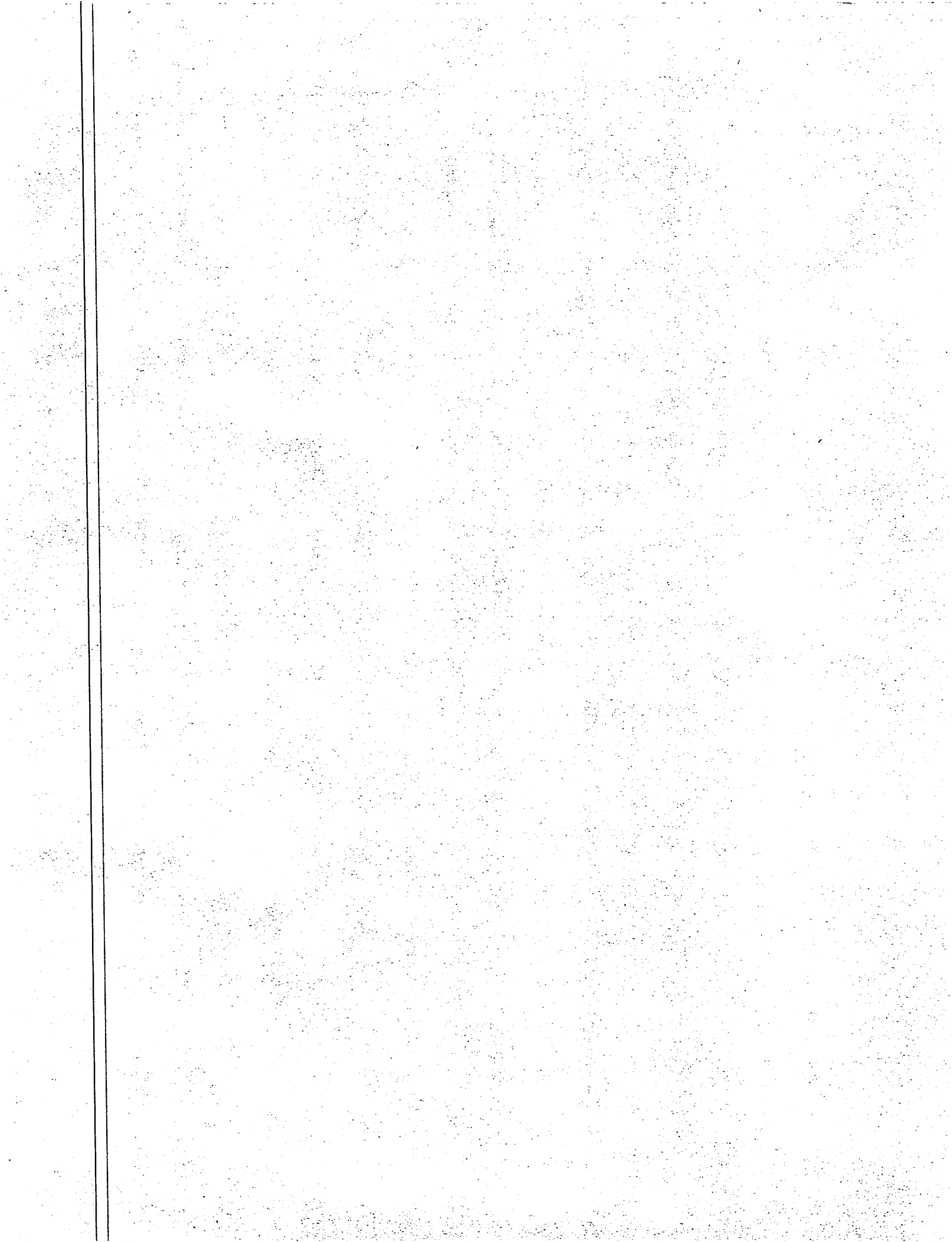
