## **ENHS 2022-2023 Sophomore Enrollment Instructions**

Please review the following information to better understand the steps involved in the enrollment/course selection process:

- 1. Use the provided Graduation Credit Check sheet and the Elective Class List to help guide your course selection process.
- 2. Review, complete, and sign the attached Enrollment Form sheet- Mark the courses you/your student would like to take for the 2022-2023 school year. This form requires parent/guardian and student signatures.
- 3. Return the <u>signed</u> Sophomore Enrollment Form to the student's English teacher by Monday, February 7th.
- 4. In early February, your student will be instructed in inputting the parent/guardian approved courses into Infinite Campus's Academic Planner.
- 5. Students who do not return paperwork will have their schedule assigned to them based on graduation requirements and course availability.
- 6. Choose your schedule carefully. Schedule changes will only be accommodated under circumstances of school error or inappropriate placement (level). Personal schedule changes requested after the <u>May 20th</u> deadline will not be accommodated.

### **Enrollment Considerations:**

- Alternate Course Selections: These are <u>required</u> in the event that a primary course selection can not be scheduled due to other requested course schedule conflicts.
- Introduction to Advance (IA) and Advanced Placement (AP): Course requests made during the enrollment process should be made very thoughtfully and deliberately.
  - Taking IA and/or AP courses can be extremely demanding. Deciding that your classes are too demanding will not result in a schedule change.
  - If you are considering IA and/or AP, it is beneficial to speak with your current teachers about their recommendations.
- Additional Unit: For the college preparatory/work ready graduation path, students are required to earn an additional unit. These could include an additional English, Math, Science, Social Studies, World Language, or Computers course. See page 9 of the EPS Course Description Book for more details.
- Francis Tuttle (FT): If you are interested in Francis Tuttle enrollment, you must still select courses as if you will be attending ENHS full time. Schedule changes will only be made after proper FT paperwork has been submitted and approved.
- Virtual Edmond If your student is planning on enrolling in Virtual Edmond, please visit the QR code on the next page and fill out the form. A counselor will be in contact with your family to complete the enrollment process.
